TRAVEL APPROXIMATELY 21.7 MILES ON HWY 34 NORTH PASSING THROUGH WOLFE CITY TO REACH THE INTERSECTION OF HWY 34 NORTH & COUNTY ROAD 3910. TURN RIGHT ON COUNTY ROAD 3910. GO APPROXIMATELY 1.2 MILES TO GET TO GREEN RANCH HOUSE ON LEFT. (NOTE: THE INTERSECTION OF HWY 34 NORTH AND COUNTY ROAD 3910 IS APPROXIMATELY 6 MILES NORTH OF WOLFE CITY.)**
